This Letter of Intent does not, and is not intended to, contractually bind the parties, and is only an expression of the basic conditions to be incorporated into a binding agreement. The parties shall not be fully contractually bound unless and until they enter into a formal, written agreement, which must be in form and content satisfactory to each party and to each party's legal counsel, in their sole discretion, and approved by the majority of each governing body.

Upon receipt of a fully signed copy of this letter, the City of Dunwoody will proceed with the adoption of the formal, written IGA.
