





Benefits of Bike Lanes

Health and Safety

- Greater separation of pedestrians from vehicles
- Increased sight distance
- Remind drivers to share the road
- Additional width for emergency vehicles

Logistics

- Improve roadway drainage
- Increase effective turning radii at intersections
- Provide emergency stopping space for broken-down vehicles
- Provide space for maintenance operations and snow storage
- Increased pavement life (heavy loads not at the edge)


