



The City of Dunwoody continues the Sustainability Plan initiative that reflects on established community values and synthesizes them into a sustainability vision, develops topic areas to focus and achieve our sustainability efforts, and develops an action plan to facilitate implementation and progress tracking.

The City is currently in the adoption phase of the process, and we need your help. Two meetings have already occurred, but there are still ways to get involved.
