Site visits will need to be conducted individually by vendors so they may locate the transformers and generate the best possible estimate based on site conditions.

GA Power


How do I schedule site visits?

There are exhibits in the RFP document that describe the approximate locations of the proposed parking spaces and transformers. The exhibits should be used for locating the equipment on-site and should not be relied-upon solely for the generation of the installation amount. Refer to the revised exhibit for Dunwoody Nature Center.

Do I need to schedule an appointment?

No—not for the sites that are public parks. They are to be visited during park operating hours. Since it is entirely the responsibility of the contractor to coordinate permission to install the units at City Hall, please do not contact the property owner until you have been selected as the successful bidder—the property owner has not been engaged yet, so we do not want them inundated with requests before they give permission for the project. If that inhibits your ability to bid on the site, the City Hall units are optional.
