



# Brook Run Skate Park Rules

**WARNING:** Skateboarding and skating are hazardous recreational activities. Use of this facility may result in death, paralysis, brain damage, concussion, broken bones, or other serious injuries.

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## **The Facility is Not Supervised. USE AT YOUR OWN RISK.**

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1. Wear safety gear. HELMETS ARE MANDATORY. Elbow and knee pads are recommended. Shirts and shoes are required.
2. CHILDREN 11 AND UNDER MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT.
3. Stay in control. Maintain proper awareness and control of speed. Do not impede or collide with others. Always skate with the flow of other skaters. Be courteous to others.
4. Do not place, drop or throw any object in the path of a patron or on the surface of the Skate Park.
5. Alcohol, tobacco, drug use and graffiti is PROHIBITED in the Skate Park.
6. Food and beverages are allowed only in the concession area. No glass containers.
7. No profanity.
8. No radios without headphones.
9. No metal pegs are allowed on BMX bikes.
10. No animals are allowed in the Skate park. Exception: Service Animals are allowed.
11. No portable ramps, rails, benches or similar equipment allowed within the Skate Park.
