	<p>Alternate 1 – Sidewalks Only</p> <p>Sidewalks (5 ft wide) would be added to the west side of Tilly Mill Road between N. Peachtree Road and Womack Road. No additional pavement width would be added to Tilly Mill Road. Bike riders would continue to use the existing travel lanes.</p>
	<p>Alternate 2 – Sidewalks and Bike Lanes</p> <p>Sidewalks (5 ft wide) would be added to the west side of Tilly Mill Road. Also, Tilly Mill Road would be widened (6-8 ft) to accommodate designated bicycle lanes (4 ft wide) on both sides of Tilly Mill Road between N. Peachtree Road and Womack Road.</p>
	<p>Alternate 3 – Sidewalks and Partial Bike Lanes</p> <p>Sidewalks (5 ft wide) would be added to the west side of Tilly Mill Road between N. Peachtree Road and Womack Road. Also, Tilly Mill Road would be widened (6-8 ft) to accommodate designated bicycle lanes (4 ft wide) on both sides of Tilly Mill Road within the existing 2-lane section (between N. Peachtree Road and Cherring Road). Bike riders would continue to use the existing travel lanes within the existing 3-lane section (between Cherring Road and Womack Road).</p>
